Mattresses, box springs, and futons only, any size. All items must be clean and dry. Please cover in the event of rain.

NOT ACCEPTED:

Wet or soiled items, furniture, frames. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item deemed unacceptable or unrecyclable.

NOT ACCEPTED

Industrial refrigerators and freezers

Porcelain Toilets & Sinks

Toilet seats and base wax rings must be removed


Shredding

Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Staples okay. No binder clips.

LIMIT: 3 file-size (12"x12"x16") boxes or equivalent quantity per vehicle – no exceptions.



Garage & Yard



Concrete, Asphalt, Rock, Brick & Sand

Place on tarp for easy removal. Rocks and smaller materials including sand must be in boxes or buckets. Remove plastic, metal and wood. Residential material only.

NOT ACCEPTED:

No bags, just the sand inside.

Propane Tanks

- Empty residential tanks
- Empty camping stove tanks



Scrap Metal

- Washers
- Dryers
- Dishwashers
- Ovens
- Stoves
- Water Heaters
- Engines
- Microwaves
- BBQ's
- Lawn Mowers
- Metal Lawn Chairs
- Swing Sets
- Cast Iron Sinks & Tubs
- Auto Parts
- Iron
- Steel
- Aluminum (cans included)
- Brass
- Copper
- Ferrous Metals
- Non-Ferrous Metals

NOT ACCEPTED:

Metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint or hazardous materials. Light fixture ballasts or Sealed drums.

Bulky Yard Debris/ Scrap Wood

- Branches (>4" diameter)
- Logs
- Clean Wood and plywood
- Pallets

All wood should be unpainted, untreated, and unstained. Please lay a tarp under materials for easy removal.

NOT ACCEPTED:

Brush, sod, grass clippings, blackberry bushes, leaves, small branches, stumps, painted, stained, treated or laminated wood or particle board.

Household Items



Reusable Household Goods/Textiles

Clean clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition

NOT ACCEPTED:

- Wet
- Broken
- Damaged items
- Furniture



E-Waste

- Printers
- Mice
- Keyboards
- Fax machines
- Scanners
- DVD/blu-ray players
- VCRs
- Cell phones
- Microwaves

NOT ACCEPTED:

TV's, Computers, Monitors (Drop off at E-Cycle Washington sites, including the Kent Goodwill and Value Village ecyclewashington.org)

Batteries

- AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, D and 9V cell batteries
- Lead acid batteries
- Rechargeable batteries
- Cellphone batteries

Cardboard

- Please flatten

NOT ACCEPTED:

- Wax-coated cardboard
