Jewelry Policy: Participants are not allowed to wear any jewelry (necklaces, earrings, bracelets, etc.) while playing. Earrings **cannot** be taped or covered, but must be removed.

Participation Guidelines: Every eligible player must play one entire quarter from beginning to end without interruption. All players **must** appear in both halves. If teams have eight (8) or more players, every player must sit out one full quarter during the game.
