Canada Goose: Great Basin:222 Cackling: 60

Bald Eagle: One adult flew from a snag at the ponds and headed NE.

Northern Harrier: One adult female over the North Ditch Area. One untagged, immature at the West Meadows.

Cooper's Hawk: An immature flew up from the N ditch area.

Red-tailed Hawk: Four adults; the NW forest pair at the NW forest. An adult from the 58 Pl. pair on a snag near the ponds. An adult from the SW towers pair on a snag at the SW.

American Kestrel: The Kent ponds pair at on a snag at the NW. The snag has a nest box.

Peregrine Falcon: The Immature female on a snag at the ponds.

Common Snipe: One flew from a wet area at the West Meadows.

Barn Owl: One roosting in the Austrian Black Pines at Anderson Park.

Brewer's Blackbird: A flock of 10 in the tree tops at the E edge of the NE woods.
