Canada Goose 35 adults and 46 young counted

Green-winged Teal A female at the constructed wetlands.

Mallard 55 adults and 38 young counted.

Northern Pintail Two males at the Lagoon.

Lesser Scaup Two males at the Lagoon.

Bald Eagle One adult on a snag and later a stump at the Ponds.

Northern Harrier A tagged [YR 5] adult male over the North Ditch Area. A tagged [YL] immature over the North Ditch Area.

Red-tailed Hawk The NW Forest Pair and the 58 Pl. Pair. Also at least one young heard at the NW Forest Pair nest.

Ring-necked Pheasant One heard crowing at the Nursery Area, another heard crowing at the West Meadows.

Greater Yellowlegs One at the shore of the Lagoon.

Least Sandpiper One at the shore of the Lagoon.

Wilson's Phalarope A female at the shore of the Constructed Wetland.

Belted Kingfisher Two males; one was seen carrying a fish from the Lagoon to the SW.

Willow Flycatcher Four singing males.

Lazuli Bunting A singing male north and south of the asphalt path at the south central part. Outside of the census area: two singing males south of the asphalt path at the southeast part.

White-crowned Sparrow A singing male pugetensis near the Nursery Gate.

Yellow-headed Blackbird An immature along the shore of the Lagoon.

Brewer's Blackbird Eight on the mudflats at the Lagoon.

Bullock's Oriole A singing male heard at the NE Woods.

House Sparrow A male in willows near the NE Gate. A male in a willow near the East Viewing Mound.
