- *1 An adult flying low from the direction of the river, east toward the 72nd Ave cell tower nest, carrying a small fish.
- *2 A first year (HY, hatch year) eagle flying over the NE. forest. WAS IT FLYING N TO S, S TO N, E TO W???
- *3 Both NW. adults soaring above the N. end of lagoon with a HY juvenile. One SW. HY juvenile in the SW. quadrant.
- *4 One HY juvenile flushed from ground, just E. of interior foot bridge and a second HY juvenile on the S. fence rail.
- *5 Three of the flickers observed where of the red-shafted variety. Is that how you say it? Are they the least common?
- *6 First heard then seen atop a small Cedar tree near the S. viewing tower.
- *7 Was the warbler Audubon's???
