### \*NOTES\*

- \*1 One un-aged Osprey flying N. to S. over the constructed wetlands and continuing S. over the S. paved trail.
- \*2 A first year (HY, hatch year) juvenile harrier flying over the NW quadrant and being pursued by two crows.
- \*3 One NW. adult flying low from SE. toward NW. forest. One SW. adult atop power tower three in SW. quadrant.
- \*4 Flyover N. to S. the loose flock of swifts appeared to be following an Osprey going in the same direction.
- \*5 Five of the flickers observed were of the red-shafted variety and the remainder were heard only.
- \*6 Of the five warblers observed, two were Audubon's and three were of the Myrtle's race.
- \*7 The cross bills flew overhead of the pond team and over the NE. forest, vocalizing their kip, kip, kip calls..

### MORE NOTES

Mammals observed were one vocal coyote in NW. wet meadow, one weasel on main dike trail and a rabbit by nursery.
